SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM

Dear Parents,

The Town of Clinton Summer Recreation Program will meet at Clinton Public School. The program will run from June 27th – July 22nd from 9am-12noon, Monday – Friday. Registration will be open to all children who have completed kindergarten through grade 8 and are residents of the Town of Clinton or Glen Gardner beginning February 21st. Registration will be open to any out-of-district student who has completed kindergarten through grade 8 as of March 15th. Registration is open to the first **250** children who enroll.

What Do I Need to Do to Register My Child?

The registration fee for the Clinton/Glen Gardner residents is \$125 for the 1st child, \$100.00 for the 2nd child, and \$75.00 for each subsequent child. The registration fee for out-of-district children is \$150 per child. In addition to the registration fee, there is a non-refundable \$5.00 fee for each field trip you sign up your child for. This fee must be included with your registration check. Your returned check is your enrollment confirmation, or you can contact me to confirm registration. **Regular registration CLOSSES on Monday, June 20th. (The late registration fee is \$175.00/child – no exceptions).*
