

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING ITEMS

Plastic bags may not be used as recycling containers and **will not be picked up!**

ALL RECYCLABLES GO IN ONE CONTAINER

You may need more than one container depending on household usage.
Please rinse out plastic bottles and containers.



All recyclables can go in one container: glass bottles and jars, metal cans, plastic bottles and containers (marked #1 - 7), junk mail, mixed paper, newspapers, magazines, and cardboard.

Newspapers and cardboard need not be tied, however make sure they are securely in the container so not to blow out on windy days. Use a lid at all times.

Acceptable Recycled Items

Hard Cover & Paperback Books
Newspaper, Magazines & Junk Mail
Telephone Books
Cardboard & brown paper bags
Clean pizza box
Lightweight cardboard

Chipboard that disintegrates when wet.
For example: cereal & macaroni boxes.
Tin & Bi-Metal Cans (label can stay on).
Food Trays #1-7 (rinsed out).
Caps may be left on plastic bottles.
Glass bottles.

Aluminum cans (only empty beverage cans).

Plastic bottles and containers #1-7: All containers **MUST** be emptied and rinsed.

BRUSH/YARD DEBRIS

Small debris - put in black plastic bags only. Do not use buckets or garbage cans. Curbside, but not in roadway.



CHIPPING WILL BE PICKED UP BY ZONES (see chart above) - All brush (tree limbs and branches) put out for chipping must face in the same direction (with the flow of traffic). No branches over 6 inches in diameter.

We **DO NOT** take roots and stumps.

NOTE: No brush will be picked up during leaf collection time.

GRASS CLIPPINGS



Grass clippings are picked up by the garbage hauler **THEY MUST BE IN SPECIAL PAPER BAGS**. Available at Shop Rite, Walmart, or your local home improvement center.

LEAF COLLECTION

Usually from mid-October through December; the rest of the year they are bagged and considered to be yard debris.



THEY SHALL NOT BE PLACED CLOSER THAN 10 FT FROM ANY STORM DRAIN INLET.

There will be multiple trips though all neighborhoods for the duration of the leaf collection program. If leaves are not out when the crew goes by, they will be picked up next time. The schedule is subject to inclement weather and other municipal emergencies.

A special springtime leaf collection will be the last week of March and the first week of April.

Electronics: Items include computers, monitors, speakers, televisions, VCR's, DVD & CD players, fax machines, stereo equipment, radios, cellular and cordless telephones, etc.



Scrap Metal: Items include air conditioners & refrigerators (Freon removed), BBQ grills, bicycles, cast iron items, dish washers, dryers/washing machines, lawn furniture, vacuum cleaners, weed wackers (gas removed), etc.

Garbage Pickup - Every Tuesday

REGULAR GARBAGE/TRASH

Every Tuesday at curbside (out before 7a.m.).

No building/construction materials, paint, auto parts, tree stumps, hazardous materials.

No electronics such as items with electric circuit boards in them such as televisions, radios, stereos, computers, monitors, etc.

These items can be dropped in our electronic dumpster at the Sewer Treatment Plant (refer to hours above) or taken to the Hunterdon County Complex at the electronic collection held three times a year. Call 908-788-1110 for information and dates.

Air Conditioners and Refrigerators must have Freon removed before pick up can be made. A sticker identifying Freon has been removed must be attached.
