#### General

### **Old Business**

- 1. Rain Garden Project update –Liz Hedden, a teacher at Clinton Public School and leader of the student environmental club, is interested in joint projects with the EC, such as installing a rain garden. She wants to first check in with the superintendent. Véronique will continue discussion with Liz Hedden and report back to the EC.
- 2. Ordinance for Covered Trash & Recycling Bins New garbage contract is due to be renegotiated for 2023. What should amendments to existing code be? Mike asked town attorney to pull a draft based on ordinances from other towns. Aim is to pass an ordinance with a one-year grace period to give us time to educate residents on new trash and recycling rules, container rules, limit on number of cans/bags per residence (or pay per bag/can), new rules about disposing bulky items (e.g. Clinton Township gives two vouchers per year to residents for a discount on tipping fees at transfer station)

## **New Business**

- 1. Community Solar Program Clinton is already part of an energy cooperative to buy electricity; but this solar program is an aggregation of solar energy. Find out more about what is in it for residents. Talk to Rich.
- 2. EV Charging Stations V to get info from SJ about programs/incentives to reduce cost and make charging stations an attractive proposition to the council.
- 3. Pedestrian crossings on Old High Way 22 Mike suggests that to get the DOT to take action on this we should start a petition.
- 4. Sept 12, 11 2 pm, at Fire Dept. Clinton Senior Brunch we need an EC rep at the table to recruit volunteers. Fair will be in the bay 11-12noon, to be followed by brunch. Plan to share info on SJ, green team, and rain gardens.

- 5. Update from Town Council Michael Humphrey Council has opted out of cannabis business in town. They want to wait for the state to release rules first. Shell station redevelopment will move ahead.
