Administrative Matters

- John called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm on Zoom.

Council Liaison (John)

- John met with resident Ken Fisher who is advocating for reduction of noise and run-off from Interstate 78. He was not able to attend tonight's meeting but did forward a package of information which was forwarded to all Commission members. Mr. Fisher has circulated a petition encouraging the DOT to act on remedying this situation in Clinton. The Environmental Commission should review and determine what steps it could take to help. The Mayor and Council has passed a resolution in support and Congressman Tom Kean Jr. has sent a letter to the DOT. John will ask Mr. Fisher to attend one of our upcoming meetings.
- John brought up a resident of Leigh Street who has concerns about development and maintenance of the drainage easement between the Leigh Street and Kings Crossing homes. John will research further.
- John mentioned that the Buildings and Grounds Committee was considering replacing the lights at the pickleball courts. John said at the Council meeting that if this were to take place, the lights should be fully shielded and properly timed or controlled as the not interfere with neighbors.

Land Use Board (Ken)

Shade Tree Commission Liaison Report (Kim)

• The Shade Tree Commission has not met yet this month, but tree removals in Pond Ridge and the Knolls are scheduled to take place on September 25-26. We received approval from the state for our tree plantings in Kings Crossing. Those are scheduled to be planted in early October,
