<u>Meeting Suggestion</u>: It was suggested that we meet with the Flemington historic commission to learn about the commission's role.

<u>Clinton Conservancy:</u> A conservancy is being formed to make Clinton beautiful. They plan on planting around the Welcome to Clinton signs and they will maintain them. Perhaps our commission can come up with some ideas on how beautify Clinton.
