<u>Minutes of October 19</u> Richard made a motion to accept the minuets as presented. Dave seconded the motion. Minutes were unanimously approved.

<u>WW1 Commemorative Exhibition Discussion</u>. Richard Miller spoke of the financial support of the exhibit, and it appears that they will make their goal. Redevelopment Zone. Originally the redevelopment zone was mapped out not including the Cyrus Fox property; however, it will now be included. Also included is the Wargo tract, gas Saigon, and the Fine Diner. It is an advisory type of development, not eminent domain. The plan will be all-inclusive.

<u>A&P discussion.</u> IGA markets in Hunterdon include Frenchtown and Bishop's in Whitehouse Station. We would encourage the Town to seek an IGA market for this site.
