Gebhardt Field

Kyle spoke of his research on the "Preservation of the Gebhardt Field and Grandstand Park Revitalization Plan." Discussion ensued. Members will read his documentation and submit comments to Kyle prior to our next meeting.

New Business

The impact of the closure of the Pony Truss bridge on the community discussion. The repair may take a couple of months. One side is open to pedestrian traffic. Signs have been posted to ensure the traffic can enter Main Street.

Face-to-face meetings of our Commission in the Leigh Mansion Annex will be resuming on the third Wednesday in September.

The Society of Architectural Historians has a membership at an annual cost of \$155 per individual. Kyle will research how the society could benefit us and volunteered to assume the membership role if no one else was interested.

The "Welcome to Clinton" sign areas need to be revitalized, and our Commission will further investigate what work needs to be done.
