WHEREAS, The Town of Clinton strives to save tax dollars, assure clean land, air and water, improve working and living environments; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Clinton has received bronze certification in the Sustainable Jersey Program; and

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERCONNECTION
AGREEMENT BETWEEN NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS
(EDNA MAHAN CORRECTIONAL FACILITY FOR WOMEN)
AND THE TOWN OF CLINTON**

WHEREAS, the Town of Clinton (hereinafter “Town”) operates a water company which serves customers within and without its jurisdictional limits; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Corrections (“NJDOC”) operates the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility (the “Facility”) located in Union Township; and

WHEREAS, the Facility requires an Interconnect Agreement with the Town for the purpose of receiving potable water from the Town during emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:19-6. 9(g), a written agreement between interconnected systems, specifying the conditions for use of each interconnection of six inches or more in diameter is required; and

WHEREAS, the Town and the NJDOC have set forth their agreement in writing substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedule A;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Clinton, Hunterdon County, New Jersey, that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Interconnection Agreement between the Town and NJDOC, which shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedule A.
